AGIA SUMMARY

AGIA is a luxury, water-oriented subdivision on the island of Great Exuma, Bahamas. Comprising approximately 60-acres, this spectacular site is built directly on the ocean and has excellent views from all locations, as the property has varied elevations above sea level. The yacht basin affords owners the security of a calm marina, with boat slips immediately adjacent to the home sites.

By purchasing a home in AGIA owners can obtain Bahamian residency, allowing travel freely in and out of the country with no restrictions on length of stay. Residency also allows owners to open banking accounts in United States Dollars and Bahamian Dollars. The developer offers several options on home design, and has an experienced construction team in place, ready to build any style of residence.

The Bahamas, a TAX FREE HAVEN just off the coast of the United States, has an ideal year around climate and is known for its beautiful, white sandy beaches and sparkling crystal clear ocean waters, AGIA awaits those fortunate few who seek a home in paradise.


THE EXUMAS Consisting of more that 365 small islands and cays, the Exumas are celebrated for their sapphire blue water, footprint free beaches and ultra exclusive resorts, reinforcing its reputation as the ultimate escape. Great Exuma serves as an anchor to this archipelago. It is served by an international airport offering daily, bi-weekly and weekly flights with several major national and international airlines. The largest of the cays, Great Exuma's main city is the laid back capital of George Town, originally settled in 1783 by American loyalists and named after King George III. With a population of 5,600 people, Great Exuma has built its reputation as a luxury travel destination. A service economy is structured to support both individual tourists and large scale resorts such as the Sandals Resort in Emerald Bay. Great Exuma is a favorite destination among yachters, golfers and families.








From his star-struck perch aboard the International Space Station in 2015, NASA Astronaut Scott Kelly christened the waters surrounding Great Exuma in the Bahamas to be, "The most beautiful place from space." When Kelly arrived home after his year orbiting the earth, Great Exuma was one of the first places he traveled to with his daughter, so they could both view the island's beauty first-hand.















ARRIVING AT AGIA

Great Exuma's international airport in George Town hosts direct flights from Nassau, Miami, Atlanta year round, and seasonally from Fort Lauderdale, Charlotte and Toronto. It is currently undergoing a major upgrade and renovation. There are docking facilities and 6 full service marinas in the islands, offering short or long term dockage for those traveling by boat. To travel between islands, transportation is available by ferries & water taxis.

A \$65 million development of the new Exuma International Airport is currently under construction, representing the single

largest investment in any Family Island airport in The Bahamas. Key components of the upgrade program are the construction of a new 60,000 ft2 air terminal building and upgrade of the runway and aprons. The new refurbished runway will be 7,000 linear feet and new aprons and taxiway.

This includes a new Fixed Based Operation (FBO) with strategic partner, Odyssey Aviation, who will be constructing the new FBO facility adjacent to the new air terminal building.

The Exumas is located in the heart of sailing routes, fishing grounds and spectacular diving that draws people from around the world. It's easy access combined with feeling of remote beauty has made it an international destination for discerning travelers and exclusive private islands.

With sandy white beaches and dazzling blue water, the island offers an array of water activities from sailing and kayaking to coral reef and cave exploring. Under its transparent turquoise waters are beautiful natural gardens of coral teeming with fish and lobster, offering a breathtaking marine environment that is truly memorable.

YACHTING & SAILING

The Exumas is the ideal destination for boaters and sailors to enjoy excellent year-round cruising in the waters of the West Indies, with boats constantly crossing from Florida to the Out Islands of The Bahamas for fishing and diving expeditions. As host to sailing competitions year round, annual regattas include The Family Island Regatta in George Town, The George Town Cruising Regatta, the Black Point Regatta, among others.

DIVING

The islands also present wonderful dive opportunities with an intriguing combination of shallow coral reefs and colorful walls. With minimal currents along the reefs, most diving is easy enough for beginners and several shallow sunken ships present an unforgettable introduction to wreck diving. For the more advanced diver, the islands offer several blue holes and underwater cave systems, along with shark feeds for the more adventurous.

ON THE LAND SIDE

Named by Travel and Leisure as Best Golf Course in the Caribbean, golfers will enjoy the Greg Norman designed golf course, home to the Great Exuma classic on the kornferry.com Tour. With more than 125 species of birds, bird-and-wildlife watchers can spend their days hiking trails and silently paddling amid the lush mangrove forests to catch a sight of famed pink flamingos and rare Bahama Parrot that call the Out Islands home. The area is ideal for star gazing, offering breathtaking sunsets and evening skies full of constellations, including unsurpassed views of the Milky Way.
